What the Program Does

The Property Tax Reduction from

Municipal Taxes reduces your city

property taxes the year following your

application. Property is defined as the

house, garage, and the lot upon which

it sits, or one acre, whichever is less. The

amount of tax reduction is based on a

araduated scale depending on income.

The income limits for applications for the assessment freeze are based on your income of the previous calendar year. "Income" is your federal adjusted gross income plus any other income (including Social Security payments) The reduction of your taxes is on a graduated scale based on income.

The maximum amount of income to receive any type of reduction in this program is:

**Single member household** (only one person in household), income less than \$5,757.00.

See table 1.1 (back of brochure) for single member household.

**Multiple member household** (include all members income), income less than \$7,764.00.

See table 1.2 (back of brochure)

for multiple member household.

#### Eligibility

- You must be 65 years of age or older OR disabled (as defined by the Social Security Act).
- You must own the property.
- Unremarried widows/widowers of persons previously qualified for the program may still qualify.
- This program is only offered in those cities that have passed ordinances allowing the reduction. (As of July 1, 2004, only Rapid City residents are eligible for this reduction.)

Application for this program does not make you ineligible for other property tax relief programs.

## To Apply

Applications must be submitted annually to your county treasurer on or before April 1st.
